
1. During the month of April 2020, the ALERT System reported precipitation within the County ranging from a low of 0.00 inches at multiple locations to a high of 0.31 inches at the Calabasas Canyon site west of the City of Nogales.
2. The Arizona Division of Emergency Management approached Staff regarding submitting the Ephraim Canyon Project as a special Pre-Disaster Mitigation Project with federal matching funds of up to ten million dollars for this year's grant cycle as the one special project for increasing community resilience to disaster. The application has been submitted to the State of Arizona, who has approved it and moved it on to FEMA for consideration. Staff has been informed that a decision should be made by August.
3. Staff is investigating the possibility of a Flood Mitigation Management Plan to address flooding issues along the Santa Cruz River Corridor. The project was approved by the Board on March 21, 2018, and the notice to proceed has been issued. Remapping of the Kino Springs Area, Caralampi Wash and Calabasas Wash are scheduled for Fiscal Year 2019-20. As is design work for projects to address issues at Bodega Drive and along Puerto Canyon. Notices to Proceed for the remapping were issued on August 22, 2019. As of January 6, 2020, all three Letters of Map Revision were submitted. With luck the maps could be changed as early as 5 to 8 months from now, with a worst case time line of 17 months. Apparently the FEMA Contractor misplaced the submissions when moving due to Covid-19. Submission documents have been resent.
4. District Staff is working with ADWR and FEMA to make the additions and changes to the Ordinance. The draft was reviewed by the County Attorney's office and the State. The State asked for some additional corrections, mostly grammatical and to reflect recent changes in references for the State Statutes. Those changes have been made and resubmitted to the State and County Attorney's office for final review. Meetings were held June 4th (Sonoita and Nogales) and 6th (Tubac and Rio Rico), on in the afternoon, and the other in the evening. Additionally, Staff meet with the Santa Cruz Real Estate Association and presented on the changes to the group on June 27th. Staff has also reached out to give a presentation to City of Nogales Staff and Elected Officials and is waiting to hear back on a date and time. Staff has contracted with WLB to provide a comparison of the Draft Ordinance to the existing ordinance and the State Minimum Ordinance to better demonstrate the changes being made. The review is also looking at

what affects will happen to our Community Rating System standing. The review has been received and is being considered by Staff.

5. Staff received no (0) Site Review Applications.
6. District Staff received eight (8) Floodplain Use Permit applications. Three (3) of the applications was located within the City of Nogales. Seven (7) were submitted via the online application created at the end of March.
7. Staff has reviewed ninety-six (96) properties for floodplain status. Two (2) from the Town of Patagonia. Seventeen (17) of the requests were from the City of Nogales.
8. Staff received one (1) drainage complaints.
9. The Town of Patagonia had no report when this report was compiled.
10. The City of Nogales had no report when this report was compiled.

Background:

The Santa Cruz County Arts for Learning Initiative is seeking to become an affiliate of Young Audiences Inc. in order to be able to apply for grants to fund arts education, have access to accredited teaching artists and arts integration curriculum, and to enrich our schools and community with the arts.

The first goal for approval of this Affiliation Agreement is to form a partnership and affiliation between the SCCSSO and Young Audiences Inc.

The second goal for approval of this Affiliation Agreement between the SCCSSO and Young Audiences Inc. is to complete the scope of work planned by the Santa Cruz County Arts for Learning Program.

Financial Implications:

This affiliation will not affect the general fund.

Proposed Motion:

Mr. Chairman, I Move to approve the Affiliation Agreement between the Santa Cruz County School Superintendent's Office and Young Audiences Inc. effective May 1, 2020.

Young Audiences, Inc.

AFFILIATION AGREEMENT dated May 1, 2020 between YOUNG AUDIENCES, INC., a New York not-for-profit corporation (hereinafter “YAI”), having its principal office at 171 Madison Avenue, Suite 200, New York, NY 10016-5110 and Santa Cruz County Arts for Learning organized under the laws of Arizona (hereinafter “Affiliate”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS:

1. YAI believes the arts can play a fundamental role in helping young people develop their intellectual, emotional and social capacities:
 - 1.1 To perceive, value, and experience the beauty and expressiveness of works of art;
 - 1.2 To create new ideas and forms of expression from a broad range of knowledge and experience.
 - 1.3 To understand one’s emotions and empathize with the feelings of others;
 - 1.4 To enhance one’s skills and understanding of other subject areas and to promote lifelong learning.
2. The general aims and purposes of YAI (hereinafter “general aims and purposes”) are:
 - 2.1 To introduce the classical and contemporary arts of music, dance, media arts, theater, visual arts and all other related art forms to young people through works of lasting value.
 - 2.2 To stimulate interest and engagement in the arts among young people, by providing arts in education programs of excellence in schools and in community settings;
 - 2.3 To provide instruction about the arts and the working practices of artists;
 - 2.4 To stimulate and engage young people in using the arts to develop their skills in other subjects and domains;
 - 2.5 To collaborate with schools, educational systems and with community institutions at large to create and carry out education programs;
 - 2.6 To provide teachers with professional development opportunities to use the arts in their regular and ongoing classroom practice;
 - 2.7 To provide career opportunities for artists’ professional development as teaching artists; and,
 - 2.8 To advocate the arts as a means and opportunity to learn, interpret and comprehend an array of understandings that have developmental, educative and social significance.
3. The YAI network is comprised of a group of independent, separately incorporated organizations that are joined in common cause and practice; these organizations share the conviction that each organization’s individual mission, program and financial well-being is enhanced and strengthened by its affiliation with one another and with YAI as a whole.

The primary purpose of YA Affiliation is to help further the mission, program and financial well-being of the YAI network.

YAI is both a national service organization dedicated to help ensure the health and well-being of each of the affiliated organizations of the YAI network, and also an independent 501(c) 3 federated organization that is responsible for the health and well-being of the YAI network in furtherance of YAI's mission.

The assets, capacities and needs of each Affiliate are unique and particular to the qualities and characteristics of each community; the strength of the YA network is a product of the health and well-being of individual affiliates and the national organization.

4. **Santa Cruz County Arts for Learning** shares the general aims and purposes of YAI as enumerated above, and desires to become an affiliate of the YAI.

THEREFORE, in furtherance of these beliefs, aims and purposes the parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I
OPERATIONS OF THE AFFILIATE

- A. **Name**: The Affiliate shall have the right to be and shall be known only by its name as above written. It shall carry this name prominently on its letterhead, programs, online materials (websites, electronic communications, etc.), brochures, promotional literature and other documents and written or promotional materials in the form and style specified by YAI and shall not use any other name or style of identification without consent of YAI. YAI may authorize other Affiliates to make use of the words "Young Audiences" and Arts for Learning, and will take reasonable measures to protect against the use of those words by persons or organizations not authorized by it to use them. Affiliate acknowledges that "Young Audiences", "Arts for Learning" and "Young Audiences Arts for Learning" (the "Trademarks") are trademarks owned solely by YAI.

For those organizations not known as "Young Audiences", "Arts for Learning", or "Young Audiences Arts for Learning", on such materials as listed above, the phrase "affiliated with the national Young Audiences Arts for Learning network" shall appear where appropriate.

- B. **Location**: The Affiliate's principal activities shall be conducted in the location specified in the addendum of this agreement and no substantial part of its activities shall be conducted elsewhere without the consent of YAI.
- C. **By-laws of the Affiliate**: The By-laws of the Affiliate shall in general conform to any model By-laws suggested by YAI for its Affiliates, subject to reasonable variation required by local law or the needs of the Affiliate as approved by YAI.
- D. **Tax Exemption**: The Affiliate shall not at any time hold itself out to be a tax-exempt organization until such status has been granted by official ruling of the Internal Revenue Service pursuant to Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and by the State and local authority indicated in the addendum to this agreement. Until such time as the Affiliate has obtained such official rulings from the Internal Revenue Service, and the State and local authority indicated in the addendum to this agreement, the Affiliate shall not hold itself out as an affiliate of YAI or take any action for which YAI may in any way be liable.
- E. The Affiliate shall at all times provide for the Affiliate's conduct and management of its affairs by officers, organized as required by YAI, to take responsibility for raising funds and developing appropriate Affiliate policies, plans, and programs to support its activities in conformity with the general aims and purposes and policies of YAI.
- F. The Affiliate shall at all times maintain offices and facilities, mail repository, telephone service during normal business hours, and personnel adequate to carry out the terms of this Agreement and to implement appropriate programs and activities of YAI.

- G. The Affiliate shall maintain itself as an entity distinct from YAI. Nothing in this Agreement constitutes any Affiliate a joint venture with or agent of YAI. YAI in no way assumes any liability for the Affiliate's debts or liabilities of any nature.

ARTICLE II

OPERATIONS OF YAI

- A. YAI shall at all times provide for its conduct and the management of its affairs by a Board of Directors and duly elected officers, to take responsibility for raising funds and developing appropriate policies, plans, and programs to support its activities in conformity with the general aims and purposes and policies of YAI.
- B. YAI shall at all times maintain offices and facilities, mail repository, telephone service during normal business hours, and personnel adequate to carry out the terms of this Agreement and to implement appropriate programs and activities of YAI.
- C. YAI shall maintain itself as an entity distinct from the Affiliate. Nothing in this Agreement constitutes a joint venture with or agent of the Affiliate. YAI in no way assumes any liability for any of the Affiliate's debts or liabilities of any nature.

ARTICLE III

SERVICES BY YAI TO AFFILIATE

YAI agrees to furnish the following services to the Affiliate, to the extent consistent with available personnel, funds, and priorities of YAI.

- A. Organization and Policy
 - 1. YAI shall supply the Affiliate with written materials and statements explaining the general aims and purposes and policies of YAI and recommended methods of building programs to meet such aims and purposes.
 - 2. YAI shall provide the Affiliate with all current statements of policies, rules, procedures and guidelines which pertain to the operations of YAI Affiliates and to the relationship between YAI and its Affiliates.
 - 3. YAI shall give the Affiliate at least sixty (60) days prior written notice of the effective date of any policy, rule, procedure or guideline which pertains to the operations of Affiliates. If during such sixty-day period a majority of the Affiliates object in writing to such policy, rule, procedure or guideline, it shall not become effective until sixty (60) days following ratification thereof as evidenced by the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the directors present at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors of YAI, a quorum being present.
- B. General Management
 - 1. YAI shall provide best practice models and consultation for the Affiliate in the following areas:
 - a. General program and administrative management

- b. Staff and Board recruitment and retention
 - c. Financial management and successful business models
 - d. Project development and associated fund raising
 - e. Public relations and promotion
 - f. Other areas of operation
2. YAI shall coordinate National Conferences and facilitate professional development workshops and educational opportunities to address member Affiliate's needs whenever necessary or appropriate.

C. Program Services

1. YAI shall provide the Affiliate with additional services designed to assist the Affiliate in development of its program.
2. YAI will seek to identify model programs and best practices from within the network and disseminate such information to the Affiliate.

D. Financial Assistance

1. YAI shall attempt to raise funds for operations of the Affiliates from national sources and to include the Affiliates for a share of grants which YAI may negotiate.
2. YAI shall seek opportunities and facilitate national vendor services in an effort to reduce expenses to the Affiliates.
3. YAI shall assist the Affiliate in developing programs for raising of funds for Affiliate operations and projects.
4. YAI shall provide consultation and assistance to the Affiliate in matters of financial management.

E. Public Relations

1. YAI shall, from time to time, issue statements via brochures, reports or other written materials that explain YAI's general aims, purposes and programs.
2. YAI shall, whenever possible, promote YAI on a national basis by way of written articles, press releases, radio, and television representation and by other special events and methodology.

F. Representation

1. YAI shall represent or coordinate representation of YAI and its Affiliates at major conferences, before federal agencies, national foundations and national corporations, or at other forums or with other organizations concerned with arts and education or related subjects whenever appropriate.
2. YAI shall promote cooperative relations with other organizations and programs, the interests of which are related to those of YAI.

G. Evaluation

YAI shall provide the Affiliate with periodic written assessment of the Affiliate's operations in vital subject areas, and will provide the Affiliate with appropriate data about other Affiliates, organizations and programs to assist the Affiliate in evaluating its own activities.

H. YAI Reports

YAI shall issue its Annual Report to the Affiliate explaining the state of the organization, its activities, and its sources and uses of funds.

ARTICLE IV

OBLIGATIONS OF AFFILIATE

The Affiliate agrees to abide by the following:

A. General

The Affiliate agrees to promote the general aims and purposes of YAI, the unity and harmony of the YAI organization and its members, and to arrange for the presentation of programs in keeping with the aims and purposes and policies of YAI. The Affiliate will not expend its funds for any aim or purpose not consistent with the general aims and purposes of YAI.

B. YAI Policies and Rules

The Affiliate shall comply with the terms of these policies, rules, and procedures of YAI as communicated to the Affiliate by YAI.

C. Artist and Programs

1. Affiliate artists shall be accredited according to policies, rules and procedures established by the Affiliate in keeping with the aims, purposes and policies of YAI.
2. YAI programs shall be developed in accordance with policies, rules, and procedures of YAI.

D. Financial

1. The Affiliate shall comply with policies, rules and procedures established by YAI regarding Cooperative Funding.
2. All fund-raising practices on the part of the Affiliate shall be consistent with standards of dignity and good taste in keeping with the laws of the community, and with the policies, rules and procedures of YAI.
3. Fund raising practices and allocations of funds to support fund raising activities of the Affiliate shall be in keeping with policies, rules, guidelines and procedures of YAI and in keeping with state and local standards.
4. All financial records and statements shall be in a form in keeping with policies, rules, and procedures of the Affiliate and YAI, with any guidelines established by YAI.

5. The Affiliate shall provide a financial statement to YAI in the form of the annual Affiliate Report, prior to August 31st of each year, based upon a fiscal year basis ending June 30th. The Affiliate shall maintain its books and records according to sound accounting principles and in conformity with policies, rules and procedures established by YAI contingent on such policies, rules, and procedures established by the Affiliate. All financial processes will comply with Santa Cruz County rules and regulations.
6. The Affiliate shall arrange for its financial statement to be prepared in accordance with policies, rules and procedures established by Santa Cruz County, and the financial statements will be audited by a Certified Public Accountant. A copy of the audited statement shall be submitted to YAI within 180 days after the completion of the audit. Affiliates with limited financial resources may request permission to submit a compilation, review, or other attestation services (including "agreed upon procedures") provided by an outside auditor.
7. The Affiliate in no way assumes any liability for any YAI debts or liabilities of any nature.

E. Reports

The Affiliate shall, at reasonable times to be specified by YAI, provide to YAI reports, data, and projections concerning the Affiliate's activities and plans including other non-financial information in the annual Affiliate Report.

F. Collaboration

The Affiliate shall promote good relations with other artistic or educational agencies, bureaus, offices or organizations and strive to develop the Affiliate program in response to needs of the community as commensurate with the general aims and purposes of YAI.

G. Certification

The Affiliate shall cooperate with YAI or agencies or individuals identified by YAI by participating in the Certification Program and fully complying with its requirements as outlined in the Certification Manual as determined by YAI. The purpose of the YAI Certification Program is to assist Affiliates to continuously improve the quality of YAI programs and operations.

H. Organizational Identity

The Affiliate shall comply with the policies, rules and specifications of the YAI Graphics Standards regarding use of the YAI logo and Trademarks and the Affiliate logo.

I. Other

The Affiliate shall ascertain and observe all local, state and other governmental requirements with respect to programs under its sponsorship, including local health, fire and safety regulations.

ARTICLE V

OBLIGATIONS OF YAI

A. General

YAI agrees to promote the general aims and purposes of YAI and work toward the unity and harmony of the YAI organization and its members. YAI will not expend its funds for any aim or purpose not consistent with the general aims and purposes of YAI.

B. Financial

1. YAI shall maintain its books and records on a fiscal year basis ending June 30 of each year and shall maintain its books and records according to sound accounting principles.
2. YAI shall arrange for its financial statement to be audited by a Certified Public Accountant. A copy of the audited statement shall be submitted to each Affiliate within 180 days after the close of YAI fiscal year.

C. YAI, the owner of the Trademarks, licenses the Trademarks to the Affiliate for use in relation to Affiliate's operations as described hereunder. The form and style of the Trademarks, as used by the Affiliate, must be approved by YAI prior to Affiliate's first use of the Trademarks. No modifications of the form and style of the Trademarks may be made without the prior approval by YAI.

ARTICLE VI

TERMINATION AND DEFAULT

A. Term

This agreement shall be terminated by:

1. The dissolution of either YAI or the Affiliate; or
2. Written notice of termination from one party to the other given at least one hundred eighty (180) days in advance.

B. Termination for Cause Upon Notice and Hearing

This Agreement may be terminated by the Affiliate or YAI at any time for failure of either to fulfill any of its obligations under this Agreement after 30 days notice to cure any default. Such action may be taken only after a hearing by the Directors of the Affiliate or of YAI, or a person or persons designated by either of said organizations, upon not less than 10 days written notice of the time and place of such hearing.

C. Waiver

Waiver by either party of any particular failure on the part of either or any other Affiliate to fulfill any obligation shall not affect or impair the rights of either in respect to any subsequent default of the same or a different kind on the part of a Affiliate, nor shall any delay or omission of either party to exercise any right arising from any default affect or impair its rights as to the same or any future default.

D. Cessation of Use of Name and Trademarks

Upon termination of this Agreement the Affiliate shall immediately cease to use the name and the Trademarks as part of its name or in connection with its operations, and shall deliver to YAI all advertising, letterheads, documents, or similar material using the name and Trademarks or any variation thereof. YAI's license and permission hereunder to the Affiliate to use the Trademarks and name shall be terminated simultaneously with termination of the Affiliation Agreement for any reason.

E. Outstanding Obligations: Unexpended Funds

Upon termination of this Agreement each party shall fulfill any and all outstanding obligations, and shall immediately return the balance of unexpended funds which each party has received from the other.

F. Obligation of Successors and Assigns of Affiliate

This Agreement shall be binding upon and shall be for the benefit of the successors, legal representatives and assigns of the parties to this Agreement.

G. Indemnification

Each party agrees to indemnify the other party for any and all liabilities incurred by it after termination of this Agreement for which the other party in any way may be held liable.

ARTICLE VII

INTERPRETATION, EXECUTION AND MISCELLANEOUS

A. Applicable Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York and Arizona.

B. Counterparts

This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be deemed as original, but such counterparts together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

Subject only to the use by the Affiliate of the Trademarks, which shall require consent or approval of YAI in advance of such use, nothing which is subject to the approval of YAI shall require consent or approval in advance; provided that if YAI specifies to the Affiliate in writing the grounds for disapproving any such thing, the Affiliate shall take such reasonable steps as may be required to obtain such consent or approval and shall advise YAI of the action so taken or proposed to be taken within 30 days after receiving notice of disapproval and shall request YAI to give the required consent or approval based on such corrective action.

D. Notices

Any notice provided for in this Agreement shall be given by certified or registered mail, shall be deemed given on the date of mailing, and shall be addressed to the chief officer of the Board of Directors with a copy addressed to the official place of business.

E. Implementation

The parties acknowledge that they have an established relationship which pertains to the subject matter of, and predates, this Agreement. Except as expressly set forth in this Agreement, the parties do not intend this Agreement to modify that existing relationship. Until new policies, rules, procedures and guidelines are established in accordance with this Agreement, existing agreements, practices, and arrangements shall control.



In my capacity as Treasurer for Santa Cruz County, Arizona, have examined the land and tax records for the lots in Rio Rico attached as Exhibit A (hereinafter the "Property") and make the following findings:

1. The property owner is Vatore LLC.
2. The property was deeded to Vatore LLC by Rio Rico Properties, Inc. by Warranty Deed recorded on December 21, 1999 at Docket 819, Page 106.
3. Prior to recording said Warranty Deed, Rio Rico Properties, Inc. recorded a Declaration of Easements, Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (hereinafter the "Declaration") which declared the Property as "open space" and forbade the erection of any "permanent or temporary structure or improvements" on the Property effectively reducing the value of the Property for development purposes to zero.
4. The tax assessment use code remained 0013 (Vacant Land-Residential-Rural-Subdivided) from the time of deeding to Vatore LLC in 1999 until tax year 2014 when it was corrected to 8800 (Limited Use) in light of the Declaration. Also in tax year 2014, the Class Code for the Property was revised from Vacant to Limited Use.
5. The Land Value assigned to the Property from tax year 1999 through tax year 2013 was consistent with land that was not subject to the strictures of the Declaration and, therefore, was overvalued for tax assessment purposes.
6. Since 1999, the Land Value was more that the market would allow and, in fact, was increased over time rather than decreased to be brought in line with its limited value. The Assessor valued most of the Property at \$2,000 for Tax Year 2015 in recognition of its limited value as open space. They are now valued at \$500.

Based on the foregoing, I have determined, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes §42-18351 that sufficient circumstances exist to justify abatement of taxes and removal of tax liens. Those circumstances are:



1. An error or omission occurred resulting in an improper imposition of a property tax, i.e. the Property has been assessed at a much higher Land Value than market value for the past twenty-one years since the Declaration was recorded limiting the use of the Property to open space only.

2. The cost of the statutory lien sale and collection procedures would exceed the revenues derived. Tax liens on the Property have been available for purchase every year since 2001 and very few have been sold. Since Vatore LLC has shown that it cannot pay its property taxes, the tax lien investment community has determined that purchasing tax liens on the Property is not a sound investment. Redemption by the owner is very unlikely. Therefore, to pursue the statutory tax lien sale has always exceeded the revenues realized from that action.

For these reasons, I request the Board of Supervisors authorize me to grant appropriate relief by approving the abatement of all liens on and property taxes due on the Property to include tax years 2000-Present.

Subject: Discussion and Possible Action to adopt Fair Housing Resolution No. 2020-06 committing Santa Cruz County to fair housing practices and identifying other actions taken to affirmatively further fair housing.

Recommendation: Staff recommends the Board adopt the Fair Housing Resolution and take the actions identified to affirmatively further fair housing.

Background: The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program requires eligible communities to annually adopt or readopt a Fair Housing resolution. This is normally done in March or early April of each year, (April being Fair Housing Month throughout the United States), and it is a requirement of the State CDBG program that this document be current and a part of a CDBG project file.

This is the standard resolution that spells out the statutory framework for nondiscrimination in housing. It also directs that the resolution be provided to the public and posted in the County Complex and the North County Facility and mailed to certain organizations in the community. We will also post fair housing posters and have fair housing brochures available for the public at the front reception desk and the central permits desk.

Financial Implications: Minimal (some postage).

Proposed Motion: Mr. Chairman, I move to adopt the Fair Housing Resolution No. 2020-06 and direct staff to undertake the actions identified in the resolution to affirmatively further fair housing.

FAIR HOUSING RESOLUTION

Number 2020-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SANTA CRUZ COUNTY ADOPTING A FAIR HOUSING POLICY, MAKING KNOWN ITS COMMITMENT TO THE PRINCIPLE OF FAIR HOUSING, AND DESCRIBING ACTIONS IT SHALL UNDERTAKE TO AFFIRMATIVELY FURTHER FAIR HOUSING.

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended requires that all applicants for Community Development Block Grant funds certify that they shall affirmatively further fair housing; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (commonly known as the Federal Fair Housing Act) and the Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988 declare a national policy to prohibit discrimination in the sale, rental, leasing and financing of housing or land to be used for the construction of housing or in the provision of brokerage services, on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, disability, familial status or national origin; and

WHEREAS, fairness is the foundation of the American system and reflects traditional American values; and

WHEREAS, discriminatory housing practices undermine the strength and vitality of America and its people;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Supervisors of Santa Cruz County hereby wishes all persons living, working, doing business in or traveling through this County to know that:

1. Discrimination in the sale, rental, leasing and financing of housing or land to be used for construction of housing, or in the provision of brokerage services on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, handicap, familial status or national origin is prohibited by Title VIII of the Fair Housing Act Amendments of 1988; and that it is the policy of the Santa Cruz County to implement programs, within the constraints of its resources, to ensure equal opportunity in housing for all persons regardless of race, color, religion, sex, handicap, familial status or national origin; and
2. Within available resources the County will assist all persons who feel they have been discriminated against in housing issues on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, handicap familial status or national origin to seek equity under existing federal and state laws to file a complaint with the Arizona Attorney General's Office or the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

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3. That the County shall publicize this Resolution and thereby encourage owners of rental properties, developers, builders and others involved with housing to become aware of their respective responsibilities and rights under the Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988 and any applicable state or local laws or ordinances; and that the County shall undertake the following actions to additionally "affirmatively further fair housing":

1. Mail copies of this resolution to realtors, banks, community organizations and the local media (list attached).
2. Post copies of this resolution at the County Complex in Nogales and the North County Facility.
3. Post Fair Housing posters in the County Complex in Nogales and the North County Facility.
4. Make Fair Housing brochures available at the front reception desk and the central permits counter at the County Complex in Nogales.



Background: The project scope is to chip seal approximately 9.8 miles of roads in Rio Rico, Santa Cruz County of existing dirt and gravel roadways to reduce the amount of dust particulates in the air caused by daily traffic.

The initial cost estimate was \$748,207, which required the County to contribute \$45,226. The new project estimate has increased to \$813,132, and under the agreement the County is requires to make up the difference of \$49,699. The alternative is to decrease the scope by 1.5 miles, but the cost increase is less than the cost for County forces to perform the project.

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE SANTA CRUZ COUNTY
 ELECTIONS AND RECORDER DEPARTMENTS TO PROVIDE SERVICES IN A
 MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this ____ day of _____, 20____, between Santa Cruz County (“COUNTY”), a political subdivision of the State of Arizona, and the City of Nogales, hereinafter referred to as a “Municipality”.

WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 11-952 allows public agencies to contract for services and enter into agreements, A.R.S. § 11-251(41), lease personal property, and A.R.S. §41-2632, engage in cooperative purchasing; and,

WHEREAS, MUNICIPALITY may hold Special/Regular elections for bond issues, recalls, overrides, *etc.* pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 9-231, 9-523, 19-201, *et seq.*, and,

WHEREAS, COUNTY is authorized, pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 11-251(3), 16-172, and 16-511, *et seq.*, to perform services concerning elections; and,

WHEREAS, COUNTY is authorized pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 16-205, and 16-503, to charge for election related services provided by Santa Cruz County Elections Department (“Elections Department”); and,

WHEREAS, COUNTY and MUNICIPALITY have determined that the use of certain services of the Elections Department and the Santa Cruz County Recorder’s Office (“Recorder”) is in the public interest, and the COUNTY agrees to provide such services.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, conditions, and obligations herein set forth, the parties agree:

1. **SCOPE.** The scope of this Agreement is limited to elections services and supplies between MUNICIPALITY and COUNTY for the primary and general elections to be held on August 4 and November 3, 2020, respectively.
2. **The Services provided by the County Elections Department are:**
 - a. Prepare ballot formats for the Municipality to be approved by the Jurisdiction.

- b. Provide the sample ballots with the Municipality measures' positions according to precincts within the boundaries of the Municipality.
- c. Provide sample ballots, if required, for public distribution and issue them through the Municipality.
- d. Provide ballots to be used in each precinct, which will allow qualified electors to vote for the Municipality Candidates and/or Measures.
- e. Conduct logic and accuracy tests as required by law and publishing all legal notices in connection therewith.
- f. Tally official results of the election(s), utilizing paper ballots or electronic ballot counting equipment as mutually agreed upon between Municipality and County.
- g. Cause the precinct election boards to utilize the copies of precinct registers, prepared from the records of the County Recorder, for the purpose of identifying the electors qualified to vote in the above-mentioned election(s).

3. The Services provided by the County Recorder are:

- a. Provide copies of precinct registers of qualified electors for precincts contained partially or wholly within the Municipality limits. Said registers shall be prepared from the voter registration records of the County Recorder
- b. **Early Voting – Indicate only one below:**

Municipality authorizes County Recorder to handle all Early Voting Functions.

Municipality will be handling Early Voting functions. The County Recorder will provide the following:

- ◆ A list of qualified electors who are eligible to vote early: such lists are to be used solely by the Municipality for Early Voting, or such other election related purposes as may be specifically authorized by law.
- ◆ A list of permanent early voters within the Municipality that are to automatically be mailed an early ballot. Said lists shall be generated from the voter registration records of the County Recorder.

4. Obligation of Municipality. The Municipality or designate thereof agrees to:

- a. Provide the Elections Department with a certification of the measures to appear on the official ballot for the Special/Regular election.
- b. Provide a certified list of measures and the order of appearance of the measures to the Elections Department one hundred fifty (150) days prior to the election.

- c. Provide nomination petitions and other necessary information to prospective candidates for council positions.
 - d. Accept candidates' nomination documents for filing.
 - e. Accept candidates' financial disclosure statements.
 - f. Accept all campaign finance statements and expenditure reports from candidates and/or candidates' campaign committees.
 - g. Provide the County Elections Office with the names of any Write-in candidates as prescribed by law.
 - h. Prepare and Issue certificates of the result of the election.
 - i. Publish all legal notices in connection with a municipal election with the exception of the logic and accuracy test notification as described in Section 2(e) of this agreement.
 - j. If the Municipality chooses to conduct their own early voting, provide the County Recorder, upon receipt and prior to processing early ballots, copies of the complete Applications of Early Ballots for signature comparison by the County Recorder or other officer in charge of elections as required by A.R.S. Section 16-550(A). These copies can be provided by mail, hand delivery, or fax as time constraints dictate.
 - k. Pay to County, on a reimbursable and pro-rata basis, all costs of personnel, election materials, and supplies expended by County pursuant to this Agreement. Municipality will make said payment to County within fourteen (14) days after presentation by County of demand for said payment.
 - l. If the Municipality chooses to conduct their own early voting, a list of all "Inactive Status" electors who voted in the election pursuant to A.R.S. Section 16-583 shall be provided to the County Recorder.
 - m. Agree to be a point of contact regarding conditional provisional ballots – in that a voter of a conditional provisional ballot can take an acceptable type of personal identification to qualify the subject conditional provisional ballot; document what type of identification is provided indicating any identification numbers and issue dates; provide a daily receipt of identification forms from conditional provisional ballot holders by the Municipality Clerk's office that will be forwarded to the Voter Registration Department of the Santa Cruz County Recorder. This can be done by fax or hand-carried.
5. **MANNER OF FINANCING AND BUDGET.** Each party represents that it shall use all reasonable means to allocate sufficient funds in their respective budgets to discharge the funding obligations imposed by this Agreement, and agrees that such funds shall be separately designated for such purpose.

6. **DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY.** The Parties do not anticipate joint acquisition of property during the term of this agreement.
7. **TERMINATION.** This Agreement shall terminate upon all matters connected with the election being resolved, legal challenges excepted or upon written notice by either party to the other within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Agreement.
8. **CANCELLATION.** This Agreement may be canceled by either party for conflict of interest pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-511.
9. **TERM.** The term of this Agreement shall begin upon approval of the parties and shall terminate as provided in Section 7, Termination, above.
10. **INDEMNIFICATION OF COUNTY.** To the extent permitted by law, each party to this Agreement shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the other party, its officers, departments, employees and agents from and against any and all suits, actions, legal or administrative proceedings, claims, demands or damages of any kind or nature which results from the acts or omission of the indemnifying party, its agents, officers, employees or anyone acting under its direction, control or on its behalf, whether intentional or negligent. Should the MUNICIPALITY'S portion of the election herein be challenged or questioned for any reason whatsoever, then, in such event, to the maximum extent permissible by law, MUNICIPALITY shall be solely responsible for defending, legally or otherwise, said election.
11. **NONDISCRIMINATION.** To the extent required by law, each party to this Agreement shall comply with all state and federal equal opportunity and non-discrimination requirements and conditions of employment, including the American's with Disabilities Act in accordance with A.R.S. Title 41, Chapter 9, Article 4, which mandates that all persons and that all persons, regardless of race, creed, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, disability, or political affiliation, shall have access to employment opportunities.
12. **IMMIGRATION LAWS.** The Parties warrant that they will at all times during the term of this Agreement comply with all federal immigration laws applicable to the Parties' employment of its employees, and the requirements of the Federal Immigration and Nationality Act (FINA), A.R.S. §§ 41- 4401 and 23-214(A), and all other federal and state immigration laws and regulations.
13. **RECORD KEEPING.** The Parties agree to keep all books, accounts, reports, files and other records relating to this Agreement for five (5) years after completion of the contract; and in addition, agrees that such books, accounts, reports, files and other records shall be subject to audit pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-214.
14. **GOVERNING LAW.** This Agreement shall be construed under the laws of the State of Arizona.

- 15. **SAVINGS CLAUSE.** Should any part of this Agreement be held to be invalid or void, the remainder of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect with those offending portions omitted.
- 16. **WAIVER.** A waiver by either party of any of the terms, conditions and covenants to be performed by the other shall not be construed to be a waiver of any succeeding breach, nor of any other term, condition, or covenant contained in this Agreement.
- 17. **BREACH.** Failure by the COUNTY and/or MUNICIPALITY to provide services/material or to provide the documentation at the time and in the manner described in this Agreement shall constitute a breach of this Agreement.
- 18. **NOTICES.** All notices *required* by this Agreement, such as notice of termination, shall be sent by U.S. certified mail, return receipt requested, or delivered by hand to the Party at the address indicated below or such other address requested by notice to the other Party. A notice shall be considered given when received.

Notwithstanding the above, any routine communications between the parties that do not affect the rights of obligations of the parties, such as communications regarding the election(s), results, canvass, or otherwise may be sent and received via email.

- 19. **WORKERS' COMPENSATION.** An employee of either party shall be deemed to be an "employee" of both public agencies while performing pursuant to this Agreement for purposes of A.R.S. § 23-1022 and the Arizona Worker's Compensation laws. The primary employer shall be solely liable for any worker's compensation benefits which may accrue. Each party shall post a notice pursuant to the provisions of A.R.S. § 23-906 in substantially the following form:

All employees are hereby notified that they may be required to work under the jurisdiction or control or within the jurisdictional boundaries of another public agency pursuant to an intergovernmental agreement or contract, and under such circumstances they are deemed by the laws of Arizona to be employees of both public agencies for the purposes of workers' compensation.

- 20. **ENTIRE AGREEMENT.** This Agreement contains the entire agreement between Parties concerning its subject matter and any amendment to this Agreement shall not be made except by mutual written agreement of the parties.
