SOUTH32 SUPPORTS VACCINE CLINIC IN SANTA CRUZ

South32 Hermosa has committed further funding to Santa Cruz County's COVID-19 pandemic efforts, supporting an additional vaccination clinic in the region.

The additional clinic will administer doses for about three weeks during April 2021 across two locations. It is part of South32 Hermosa's broader support to the County during the pandemic.
