What: SCC Vaccination Program Expands to ages 12-15

Where: Santa Cruz County

Santa Cruz County and Mariposa Community Health Center are expanding the vaccination program after the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention recommended Pfizer's COVID vaccine for use in children, ages 12-15.

Pfizer is the only vaccine approved for use by those who are ages 12-17. The other two COVID vaccines in the United States made by Moderna and Johnson & Johnson are still only available to people ages 18 and older.

Residents may choose to register for an appointment, however walk-ins will be accepted for ages 12 and older.
